In 2012, Foundation Beyond Belief created an international Light the Night (LTN) team to support the Leukemia Lymphoma Society in its fight against blood cancers.

Led by Todd Stiefel of the Stiefel Freethought Foundation, the FBB team raised over \$439,000 in its inaugural year, setting the following records in the process:

- Most raised by a first year non-corporate team in LTN history
- 4th largest fundraising team in the country, including corporate teams
- Most local teams (150) for an LTN international partner team in 2012
- Top new international team of 2012
- Top non-corporate team in 2012
- The top overall individual fundraiser the country

The table at left shows the total raised by state and among our Canadian teams in 2012. Our goal for 2013 is \$500,000.
